



## MS. GRAY'S THIRD GRADE SUPPLY LIST FOR 2009-2010

Dear Parents,

Third grade is right around the corner. We are eager to meet your child and get the year off to a great start! Your child has a wonderful year ahead with many exciting challenges and learning experiences.

Please take note of the following list of items, and have them ready to send with your child on the first day of third grade.

- 2 packages of **wide ruled**, loose leaf notebook paper
- 1 package of multi-colored construction paper (regular or double sized)
- 1 package of pencils with erasers; pencil grips optional
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 or 2 large pink erasers
- a few colored pens to use for checking/correcting work
- **EXPO** dry erase markers– 4 **pack (thin)** and 1 eraser (for individual math boards)
- 2 fluorescent colored highlighters
- Scissors (**pointed**)
- glue (1 small bottle of Elmer's liquid and 2 sticks)
- 1 or 2 boxes of Kleenex
- a healthy snack (enough for 20 students); a monthly rotation schedule TBA will be created for the remainder of the year
- **One** 70-100 page spiral notebook to be used as a third grade journal
- a 3-ring binder (1 **1/2-2 inch**) w/ pockets on inside covers
- Dividers w/ colored tabs for binder (**7 total**– 1 for each subject); **must be pre-labeled w:** math, science, social studies, reading, English, spelling, & vocabulary
- 3 pocket folders (1 **MUST BE RED** to be used as a stay @ school folder); the other 2 can be any color, but must be **hole punched**.
- 1 French binder; accordion style file folder to hold papers & workbook
- A ruler with metric and standard measurement (**inches and centimeters**); wood or hard plastic (**non-collapsible**)
- Paper towel cardboard tube; (sent in a plastic newspaper bag would be great!)
- **Boys:** 1 box of ziploc bags (qt. or gal.) and 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- **Girls:** 1 package of napkins and 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- Optional: supply box or pouch for storage of supplies in desk

\*\*Additional items may be purchased and sent at your discretion, but these are the only items necessary for the daily classroom routine. A daily assignment notebook will be provided and used for recording homework responsibilities.
