

Middle School Supplies for 2010-2011

Please keep in mind that each teacher may have additional supplies to discuss with your child on the first day of school and/or during the year.

Organizational Helpful Hint: try to color coordinate your folders and notebooks so that each subject is represented by one color. (ex: for science use a green folder/green spiral notebook)
